PHILOSOPHY

Our curriculum philosophy is based on the Reggio Emilia approach, which respects the ideas, interests and development of each child. Class projects and emergent themes are developed through collaboration of the children in a rich environment, which provokes exploration, curiosity and creativity. Literacy, language development, mathematics, science, gross and fine motor skills and swim instruction, for children ages three to five years, are integrated into the curriculum. Staff promotes the four YMCA character values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.

HOURS OF OPERATION

The Countess deHoernle Youth Learning Center will open at 7:30 a.m. and close at 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

We maintain an open door policy; therefore, parents are always welcome to visit our center at any time. Parents are encouraged to participate in our program as volunteers.
