YMCA @ 901 CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE:

1. Obtain waitlist form.
2. Submit completed waitlist form along with waitlist/registration fee (please keep in mind, desired start dates are not guaranteed, they are based on current enrollment and capacity).
3. Official start date will be determined once current enrollment and capacity is evaluated.
4. One week prior to official start date, contact the Director to schedule a classroom visit. This visit allows you and your child to meet the teachers and acclimate to the classroom environment.
5. Prior to first day, submit completed enrollment packet, medical records (well physical and immunizations) and tuition payment information.
