Also present was the first female CEO of the YMCA of Boca Raton, Carol Seewald Clinton, who shared a variety of memories from her tenure (1980-1989).

Although not in attendance, Peter Blum, one of the Boca Y's founding members, made an appearance via video, sharing his Y memories and joyfully sang a YMCA camp song that he had learned more than 80 years ago.
